Marlin takes these recycled steel coils and converts them into precisely engineered wire products for industrial users like GE, Honeywell, Boeing, Toyota, Siemens, Roche, Novartis, Baxter and Pfizer.

What You Will See:

On this tour, you will hear how [Marlin helps promote manufacturing sustainability](#) within its own factory by recycling all scrap steel and turning its scrap from a nuisance into profit. Besides being good for the company's profits, this also reduces Marlin Steel's environmental footprint. During this tour, you will also see how quick-changeover teams have reduced setup times and batch sizes; how RM has dropped through supply chain improvements; how WIP was dramatically reduced through cells with single-piece flow; how FG was slashed by reducing lead times; how shared weekly performance bonuses helped beat production targets; and how cross-training matrix is used to boost skills, cover weekly schedules and broaden team member work experience.

There is a lot to be learned from attending this tour.
